RESOLVED to object to the proposed illuminated sign which was within the conservation area development. It was the only illuminated sign at right angles to building in this section of the High Street and it was felt this was likely to set a precedent and was not in keeping with the character of the High Street.
21.03.14	CB/14/00953/ FULL Mr & Mrs Austin 36 Carter Street Sandy SG19 1BT	Revised window and door layout including new window to west elevation and change to window colour from the approved plans and details at 36 Carter Street, Sandy, Beds. Retrospective application to replace a window with full length windows and a door.  RESOLVED to make no objection to the proposed development which made no impact on the street scene.  However the committee wished to draw to CBC's attention to the fact that these developers have built in the town previously and this is third occasion when the development has not built according to the planning permission granted (ie
21.03.14	CB/14/00951/ FULL Mr S Bloomfield 2 Hawk Drive Sandy SG19 2WA	29 Bedford Road and the Coach House on the corner of the Avenue had also been the subject of alterations).  First floor side extension at 2 Hawk Drive, Sandy, Beds.  RESOLVED to make no objection to the proposed development as it would balance the appearance of the house by complementing an existing extension and would have no impact on immediate neighbours.
