As of 16th March 2022 (data reported up to 13th March 2022)



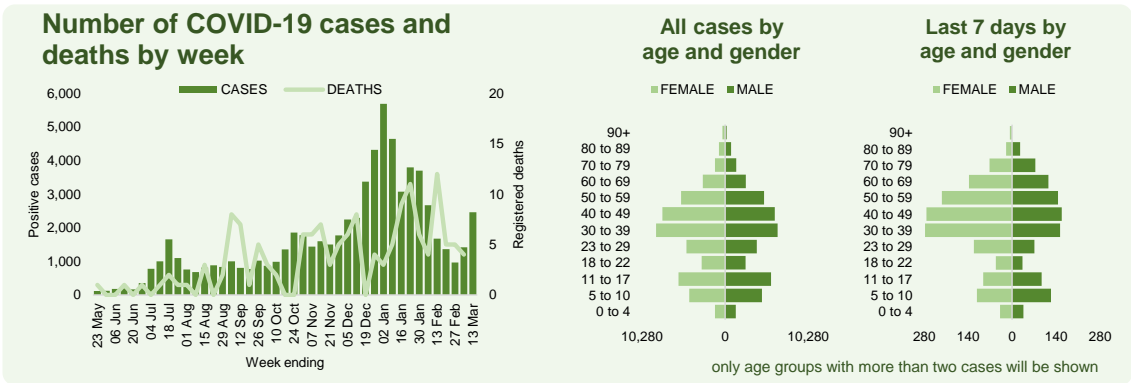
Recent falls in cases partly reflect changes in national testing policy and changing testing behaviour. Local case rates will increasingly under-estimate the number of infections in the community.

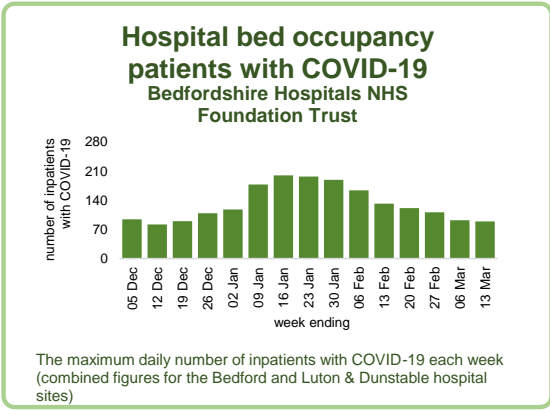
