- ✓ small electrical items
- ✓ white goods
- ✓ wood
- ✓ old textiles not suitable
for reuse
- ✓ broken toys
- ✓ excess recycling

We cannot accept:

- ✗ asbestos
- ✗ paint
- ✗ rubble, soil or hardcore
- ✗ DIY waste
- ✗ batteries (accepted but
needs separating)
- ✗ car parts
- ✗ chemicals
- ✗ commercial/business waste
- ✗ gas bottles

on how to dispose of the items we cannot accept on the day.



The councils reuse shop will also be collecting items in good condition.

We can also accept the following items in a re-usable condition:

- bags and luggage
- soft furnishings (with a valid fire safety label)
- furniture (large and small items with a valid fire safety label)
- bicycles, bike racks
- sports equipment (except safety equipment)
- books, CDs, DVDs
- picture frames and mirrors
- kitchenware (e.g. crockery and cutlery)
- toys and games (non-electronic, non mains-powered)
- garden items

Please note: We cannot accept electrical items or safety items such as car seats. All stuffed furniture and soft furnishings must have a valid fire safety label.
